For the first time in 25 years the Australian SAS lifts the veil of secrecy on what it takes to pass the toughest military selection course in the world. Candidates try and make the cut for one of the most elite fighting forces in the world. Over three weeks the candidates face sleep deprivation, brutal physical exercise and constant questioning; all designed to break down the body and mind to get to the heart of the man. For many, the mind games and physical demands are too much and the number quickly whittles down to half after they are forced to sign away their chance to ever apply again. The last men standing then face a massive 150km mountain hike carrying 50kg packs and a fictitious civil war where they must obey orders from Guerrilla leaders whilst receiving no sleep or food for five days. Their lives become sheer physical and mental hell. Candidates fall like flies. On the last day only a handful have made it, yet their SAS careers are not guaranteed. The remaining few now face eighteen months of training before they have the right to join the elite ranks of the Australian Special Air Service Regiment.
