
Media Luna New Films represents directors and producers with a handwriting signature on their work. We focus on international productions by talents, who demand to emerge through their original approach and their unique style.

Joy Verberk



■ DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

Who we are, where we come from and go to, these are philosophical questions without an ever satisfying explanation. But simplified, broken down to only relate to ourselves, these questions are a lot easier to answer.

I was always interested in the role of origin, family history, and the impact our parents have on us. As son of a Dutch mother and a Nigerian father, I know too well what it is like to grow up between two cultures and the feeling that I don't really belong anywhere - a poignant contradiction that forms the core of the problem of the main character in Femi.

Femi creates a bridge between social and magical realism. It is a story about a boy fighting a battle with his demons. To him, suicide is the only way to beat them. In addition to a gripping character study, I wanted to give the audience an emotional experience, recognizable and encouraging for anyone who has had that struggle before.

I began my journey with Ann Lovett in 2018. I remember the talk in our house and how people reacted to her death and that of her baby son Patrick. She knew that her baby was coming. She hid it well from almost everyone. She brought a scissors and a page from her science book showing her how to cut the cord. She was not prepared. And she was 15 years old. Set in 1980's rural Ireland, this is an amazing story of grit and determination and pure horror at the same time.

■ DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

Time freezes when every moment spent together can be the last one. Saying goodbye is a process driven by hope and denial, cut short by the arrival of Death. The one who leaves and the one who stays behind: both feel guilty of abandoning the other.

Splendid Isolation was born out of the urge to respond to that moment. I have adopted a lyrical tone to approach the subject of death that allows us a view from an intimate perspective. For me, it was a return to the essence of filmmaking.

■ DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

For a long time, I have wanted to make a film about children. The Sleeping Beast is not a children's film although I wouldn't hesitate to recommend it to them. But we don't offer simple solutions or morality. We speak in half-tones - both bright and dark ones.

The violence of the fairy tales has found its way back into the games of the children and as the line between fantasy and reality gets increasingly blurred, a sort of naïve romanticism and beauty still remains in their games.

THE SHADOW HOUR

Jochen Klepper was a German writer and journalist, who lived with his Jewish wife Johanna and his stepdaughter Renate in Nazi era Germany. When towards the end of 1942 the deportation of his family seemed imminent, he was faced with an impossible choice. Klepper made his decision despite all consequences. Thousands of Germans at that time did the same.

■ DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY Benjamin Martins

Initially studied drama in Cologne and Berlin before debuting as a director in 2014. Three years later he and his dog 'Muesli' founded the film production company Herbsthund Filme. He was soon nominated for several major German film awards including the 'first steps award' and the 'German Cinema New Talent Award' at the Munich Int. Film Festival.

Beate Krist



Ralf Drexler


is a German actor who worked for a number of feature films and TV series on German TV, such as *Cologne*, *P.D.* and crime hit show *Tatort*.

■ PRODUCER'S STATEMENT Eva Habermann

For me it was a matter of the heart to produce a film about the subject of depression. I am someone who knows what I am talking about, because I have experienced it firsthand. Addiction to alcohol and prescription drugs is often a direct result of this illness, to blend out the pain. The biggest problem is that depressions still are perceived as a shortcoming of the sufferer. It still is a shameful subject that is rarely understood, even by the ones closest to us.







BLOOD-RED OX

Amir and Amat are invited to a trip into the South American rain forest, but the pleasant visit to Bolivia quickly takes a bizarre turn as Amat starts having strange visions and loses his mind over the ghostly presence of a giant blood red ox. Amir must save his boyfriend from paranoia but he will quickly realize he can't trust nothing and nobody - as he might be losing his mind too.

■ DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY

Rodrigo Bellott

is known as one of Bolivia's most prominent visual artists. In 2001, he helmed his breakout hit, *Sexual Dependency*, which won the Fipresci Award in Locarno and became Bolivia's first official selection competing for Best Foreign Language Film at the Academy Awards. In 2007, Variety named Bellott as one of the Top Ten Latin American talents to watch. He later produced his first American horror film, *We Are What We Are*, which premiered at the Director's Fortnight section at the Cannes Film Festival.






