Harald Schrott



Lina Wendel



I am not interested in questions of quilt or responsibility. I want to explore how the denial of a real confrontation with the past prevents a kind of healing and how this affects the next generations. These poisoned, heartless family atmospheres make it difficult for the next generation to take responsibility.

We live in a Mexico where organized crime is in control. Cartels massacring innocent people and authorities corrupted by these organizations, doing nothing for money. In a country that seems to have no remedy, the film narrates this to the extreme. With courage (a consequence of their innocence) and the desire for things to improve, they decide to take justice into their own hands and do the unthinkable. End this organizations.

Set in 1980's rural Ireland, this is an amazing story of grit and determination and pure horror at the same time.

Hannah Ehrlichmann


Studied acting at the Felix Mendelssohn Bartholdy. She made her debut there as Margarete in Faust, and was seen as Stella in A Streetcar Named

■ DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

LASVEGAS is my attempt at understanding the origins of violence. On the other hand, I did not want to merely do a retelling of the real-life case this film is based on but turn it into an escapist love story. I did not want to make a calculating movie but a warm one – a dark embrace. One I can cry to without leaving the theater feeling sick.










